HSS Picnic

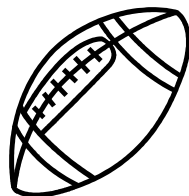
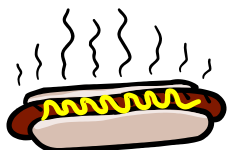
