If your child's teacher checks the box stating that a conference is necessary, she will also give you a scheduled time for the conference. If you cannot make it to the school during that scheduled time, please let the teacher know so you can have a phone conference instead.

Please keep in mind that walk-in conferences will not be conducted on this day. Also be courteous to other parents by showing up to your conference on time. We look forward to a smooth Parent/Teacher Conference day.

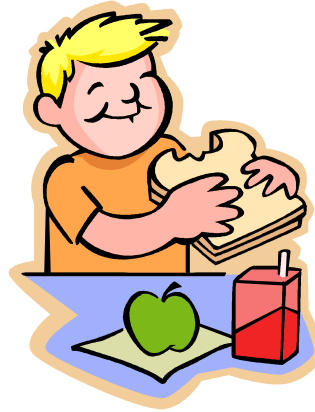

the bee at home. Classroom spelling bees will occur on November 4th, and the class champion will participate in the school-wide bee on December 2nd. Good luck!

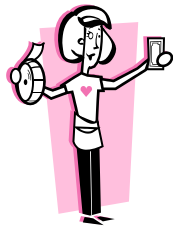


Lunch Balances

Flu Prevention Tips

Proper and consistent hand washing is one of the easiest ways to prevent the spread of flu.

- Wet hands with water and apply soap, about the size of a quarter.
- Rub hands together vigorously for at least 20 seconds (sing Happy Birthday) covering all surfaces of the hands and giving added attention to fingernails.
- Rinse hands with water.
- Dry thoroughly with a disposable towel.
- Use towel to turn off faucet

Avoid sharing objects such as utensils, cups, and bottles.

Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze and wash your hands afterwards. If tissue-less, cough or sneeze into your elbow or upper arm, not your hands.

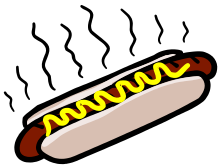
Keep your hands away from your eyes, nose and mouth to keep germs from entering your body.
