It only takes a small gift to light up the heart of a child. This is a great way to teach our children generosity and kindness during the holiday season. Thank you all in advance for your donations and support!!!

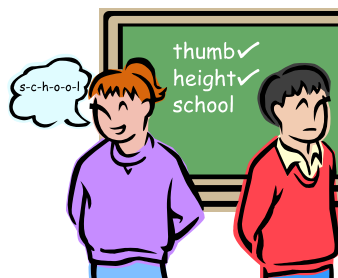
Science Fair

The winners from the class room Spelling Bees will compete against one another for the school wide Spelling Bee on Friday, November 2nd. This will begin at 12:30 until

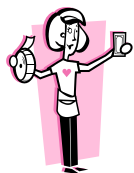
it's over. Parents are welcome to attend. We're so proud of our students!
